## **NOTES**

- The decrease in the average grant size from \$29,000 to \$23,000 over this period is due partly to having more grant partners but also to the reduction in our largest grant to a single organization from \$100,000 to \$50,000.
- Our grantmaking is more diverse and inclusive, but not any more equitable.
  - More partnerships with BIPOC-led organizations 13 out of the 25 partnerships entered during this time.
    Conversely, we exited 17 partnerships, only one of those being BIPOC-led.
  - While we are making some progress, our support to BIPOC-led organizations has not changed very much.
    If we look at the partners that have received the most funding, we see that the top 5 are all white-led organizations.
    - 9 organizations have received over \$200,000 in funding. None of them are BIPOC-led
    - 19 organizations have received \$150,000 or over in funding, only 2 of which are BIPOC-led
    - 33 organizations have received \$100,000 or over, only 3 of them are BIPOC-led.
- Maddox has seen little change in terms of policy-related partners.
